She received her bachelor's degree in political science and public administration in 1978.

Tanya began her career at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) as a Grants Management Specialist. She excelled during her 35 years at NIH where she received several awards for her leadership and her work on life science grants. She was especially fulfilled by her work with Native American communities. Tanya gave her life to Christ at an early age and was a longtime member of Brightwood Park United Methodist Church. More than anything, Tanya was a devoted and loving mother to her pride and joy – Alyssa and Amber. Upon her retirement, the real adventure began. Tanya started volunteering at The Edge Salon, traveled the world, took art classes, and joined the Takoma Park “Swim Team.”

Tanya will be met in heaven by her Grandmother Alice, her parents, brother George, and beloved cousin Beverlye.
