Charles (Charlie) James Gorham was born on September 14, 1940, in Greenville, North Carolina. He was the second child born to the late Lossie Gorham and Silas Gorham. He had one brother who preceded him in death.

Charlie attended and graduated from Dunbar High School, while he was living on the east side with his father. After graduation he moved to the westside to join in with his mother and his other siblings. He joined Christian Memorial Church (CMC) and he and his brother started a singing group on the outside and later brought them all into CMC. They sang as the "Harmonizers". He married the late Alma Benjamin and from that union they had three children. Later he married Marlene Pryor. There were no children from this union. However, Marlene had two boys from her previous marriage.

Charlie was employed as an MTA Driver; he retired after 30 years of service. He also drove a chartered bus to pick up children from their homes and take them to school, and from school to their homes. He drove for Brown's Bus company.

During his brother, Rev. Oscar Gorham's time preaching in the pulpit, Charlie also started preaching in CMC. He also fellowshiped with Faith Deliverance Revival Center Church. He would always encourage those he met on the MTA Bus or on the street to, "seek the Lord, while He yet may be found". He also

loved to bowl and to spend time with his family. Charlie had many surgeries. And the most memorable one was his heart transplant.
